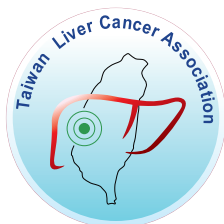


Brief Introduction to the Society



Taiwan Liver Cancer Association (TLCA)

The Taiwan Liver Cancer Association (TLCA) was officially founded in May 2008. The current president is Prof. Yi-Hsiang Huang. There are 453 members currently, including hepatologists, hepatobiliary surgeons, pathologists, interventional radiologists, radio-oncologists, medical-oncologists and basic researchers of liver cancers. Taiwan Liver Cancer Association, formerly known as Taiwan Liver Cancer Study Group, was established in July 2003 by Dr. Chung-Kwe Wang. After five years of continuous meetings with all the enthusiastic members, he had the vision to see the necessity of founding the TLCA.



Liver cancer is the leading cause of cancer death in Taiwan. The mission of TLCA is to update and improve the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of liver cancer, exchange liver cancer treatment technology and experience, promote basic research in hepatology, communicate with internationally renowned scholars and host international symposiums. With the mission of promoting the internationalization of the association, TLCA-Korean Liver Cancer Association (KLCA) joint symposium have been held in Taiwan and South Korea in 2024. TLCA will further collaborate with Japan Liver Cancer Association (JLCA) in 2025.
