Taiwan Surgical Society of Gastroenterology (TSSG)

Taiwan Surgical Society of Gastroenterology was founded in 1987. The objective of the Society is to integrate professional development, to organize periodical meetings, and to recruit new GI surgeon specialist, and hospital accreditation. For the past 36 years, 18 Presidents dedicated themselves to the Society, so that we have the scale of 2,300 members now.



To fulfill certain circumstances of different stages, the title of the Society changed from “Surgical Society of the Republic of China” in the beginning, to “Taiwan Surgical Society of Gastroenterology” in 2003, then to “The Juridical Association Taiwan Surgical Society of Gastroenterology” in 2012. Now, the title is “Taiwan Surgical Society of Gastroenterology” .

The Executive Committee consists of 27 directors and 9 supervisors. There are six special committees assisting different operation of the Society, including Validation Committee, Academic Committee, Education Committee, Policy Committee, International Affair Committee, and Quality Management Committee. In the last two years of COVID 19 lock-down era, all the meetings were held in the virtual version. Since later half of 2022, all the meetings changed to hybrid form with both on site and on line meeting.

With the contribution of our outstanding members, I believe our future is hopeful, our journey goes forward, and the state of our Society is strong.
