Taiwan Surgical Society of Gastroenterology (TSSG)

Taiwan Surgical Society of Gastroenterology was founded in 1987 by Prof. Kai-Mo Chen, who was the Director of Surgical Department, National Taiwan University Hospital. The objective of the Society is to integrate professional development and to organize periodical meetings. For the past 35 years, 18 Presidents dedicated themselves to the Society, so that we have the scale of 2,287 members now.



To fulfill certain circumstances of different stages, the title of the Society changed from “Surgical Society of the Republic of China” in the beginning, to “Taiwan Surgical Society of Gastroenterology” in 2003, then to “The Juridical Association Taiwan Surgical Society of Gastroenterology” in 2012. Now, the title is “Taiwan Surgical Society of Gastroenterology”.

The Executive Committee consists of 27 directors and 9 supervisors. There are six other committees assisting different operation of the Society, including Validation Committee, Academic Committee, Education Committee, Policy Committee, International Affair Committee, and Quality Management Committee.
